CPP Bootcamp

Option 1: online (4-hour (morning) MS Teams sessions) **Date:** 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 15, 16 plus 17 February (full-day exam training)

Option 2: on-site: **Date:** 11, 12 & 15, 16 February 2021 **Location:** Landgoed Halsaf, Babberich, The Netherlands

This bootcamp is a dynamic course, aimed at preparing candidates for the CPP exam. Candidates are expected to read the study material before the course starts to ensure optimum results. A 2-hour online kick-off will be organized in December 2020 to guide participants through the syllabus.

Costs

Early bird registration:

Registration after 31 December 2020:

€ 2.199 (excl. VAT)

This includes course handouts and Q&A preparation sessions. In case of an on-site bootcamp refreshments and lunch are included.

To ensure an interactive training environment, the number of candidates will be limited to ten.

The computer-based exam will be scheduled on **17 February 2021** (date to be confirmed) at the Prometric Testing Centre in Amsterdam or via Remote Proctored Examination.

CPP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates wishing to take the CPP examination must meet the following eligibility requirements:

WORK EXPERIENCE

Nine (9) years of security experience, at least three (3) years of which shall have been in responsible charge of a security function

OR

Earned a Bachelor's Degree or higher from an accredited institution of higher education and have seven years of security experience*, at least three years of which shall have been in responsible charge of a security function

STUDY HOURS

ASIS International advises to plan on 250 study hours. The DutchRisk CPP Bootcamp is aimed at maximizing the efficiency of those study hours
