#### PCI domain one: Case Management (35%)

- ✓ Analyze a case for applicable ethical conflicts
- ✓ Analyze and assess case elements, strategies, and risks
- ✓ Determine investigative goals and develop strategy by reviewing procedural options
- ✓ Determine and manage investigative resources necessary to address case objectives
- ✓ Identify, evaluate, and implement investigative process improvements

#### Domain three: Case Presentation (15%)

- ✓ Prepare report to substantiate investigative findings
- ✓ Prepare and present testimony

#### PCI domain two: Investigative Techniques and Procedures (50%)

- ✓ Conduct surveillance by physical, behavioral, and electronic means in order to obtain relevant information
- ✓ Conduct interviews of individuals to obtain relevant information
- ✓ Collect, preserve potential evidentiary material for assessment & analysis
- ✓ Conduct research by physical or electronic means to obtain information
- ✓ Collaborate with and obtain information from other agencies and organizations possessing relevant information

#### PCI ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates wishing to take the PCI examination must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- ✓ Five years of investigations experience, including at least two years in case management, AND
- ✓ A high school diploma or GED equivalent, AND
  - Be employed full-time in a security-related role
  - Not have been convicted of any criminal offense that would reflect negatively on the security profession, ASIS or the certification program
  - Sign and agree to abide by the ASIS certification code of conduct
  - Agree to abide by the policies of the ASIS Certification programs as outlined in the certification handbook
