Candidates wishing to take the PSP examination must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- ✓ Four years of progressive experience in the physical security field, AND
- ✓ Bachelor degree or higher from accredited institution higher education, OR
- ✓ Six years of progressive experience in the physical security field, AND
- ✓ A high school diploma, GED equivalent, or associate degree, AND
  - Be employed full-time in a security-related role
  - Not have been convicted of any criminal offense that would reflect negatively on the security profession, ASIS or the certification program
  - Sign and agree to abide by the ASIS certification code of conduct
